SCHOLARSHIPS - FEES AND EXPENSES

Scholarships for International Students

1. The Cross-Cultural Scholarship

The Cross-Cultural Scholarship is available to <u>all</u> international students who are admitted to Winona State University and hold the F-1 Student Visa. Students receiving the Cross-Cultural Scholarship pay the Minnesota Resident rate of tuition, which is lower than the Non-Resident rate.

Renewing the scholarship for your second year at WSU is a simple process by completing the following:

- 1. Complete 4 Cross-Cultural Scholarship projects during the academic year
- 2. Maintain a 2.75 cumulative GPA
- 3. This scholarship is renewable based on meeting specific criteria by the advertised deadline

2. The Presidential Honor Scholarship

The Presidential Honor Scholarship is offered to new international students in recognition of academic excellence. The initial award is based on the students SAT, or ACT, or TOEFL, or IELTS score and is renewable annually based on the grade point average at WSU and the Presidential Honor Scholarship requirements. (*Please Note: This scholarship is not available for transfer or graduate students.*)
